



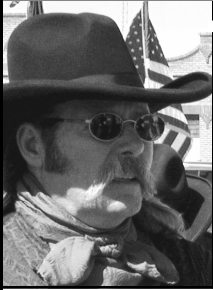

### **.22 CALIBER MATCH CATEGORY**

We want to remind everyone that there is a non-competitive .22 class at the Shaketail matches. This class is designed for shooters who want to play with us but aren't comfortable yet with large caliber rounds and heavy shotgun loads. This special class is limited to juniors (12 to 16) and women. You must use a .22 single action pistol, a .22 lever action (or exposed-hammer pump) rifle, and a 20 gauge (or smaller) shotgun. Short, Long, or Long Rifle ammunition with any bullet type is allowed. NO .22 Magnum or High Velocity, please! All shooters *must* be familiar with shooting and safe firearm handling. If you have any questions about the rest of our rules for this category, please contact the Mayor or one of the members of the Town Council.

### **ST. PATRICK'S DAY PARADE**

Once again we're participating in the Old Colorado City St. Patrick's Day Parade. This is probably the best parade we march in; there are lots of entries and spectators. *ALL* cowboys and cowgirls are invited to come, whether or not you're a Shaketail, or even a shooter. (Yes, shooters, you can wear your iron, but remember it's a bit of a walk and iron gets heavy.) If you're a non-shooter who enjoys dressing up in period costume, here's a chance to get involved in the fun.

The date is Saturday, March 12th. The parade starts promptly at 12 Noon, so we need to get together between 11:00 AM and 11:30 (there will be traffic). To find Old Colorado City, go to the US24 exit of I-25 in Colorado Springs. Head west on US24. The parade is along W. Colorado, which runs parallel to US24 on the north. We will probably line up around 27th and W. Colorado. However, we will also have some people meet at 31st and W. Colorado at the Red Rocks Shopping Center if it's easier to find us there. Please bring the family and have some fun!
