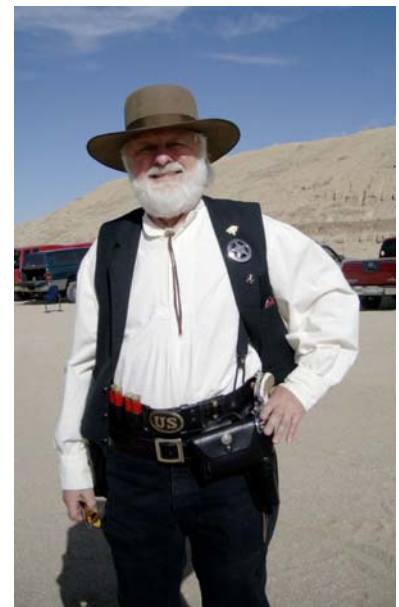
Shootin' Hoosier put on a very impressive slide show. Thanks Hoosier. He even put some pictures up on the website.
