Next up is the night shoot. We will be shooting three stages at night so that will need extra ammo as will the side matches. Well guys we'll be busy in the loading room for the next month. But we like it and our ladies are worth it. I don't

have a full load count yet but 8 main match stages, 3 night shoot stages and all the side matches will bring you to about 250- 300 rifle and pistol and maybe 75-80 shotgun. Depends on how far you go in the Man on Man and Top Gun. Looks like I'll be on the low end and Snuffy on the high so I'll still be busy.

I look forward to seeing you all there so let's load up and have some fun. Until we meet on the Range; Have happy 4th of July and remember those that gave all and those still giving to allow us this freedom and this great Country.
