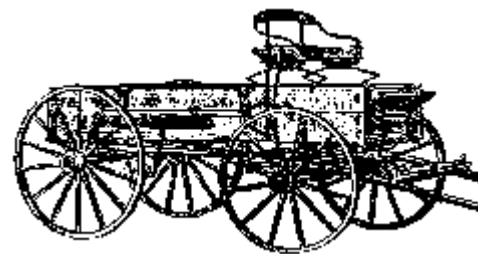
TG's Corner
